TECHNOLOGY REQUIREMENTS

St Agnes Catholic High School participates in a mandatory 1:1 (one device per student) device program where incoming Year 7 students supply their own laptop for their learning journey.

It is compulsory for students to have a laptop or a Chromebook. While we understand iPads may have been used in primary schools, we do prefer our students to use laptops.

RECOMMENDED DEVICES ([CSPD Bring your own device \(BYOD\) Guidelines](#))

Apple Macbook Air (preferred option).

Other options: LAPTOP - Lenovo, Asus, Dell or HP with Windows 10 or 11, 8 GB memory, 14 inch screen size with a recommended battery life of at least 5 hours or a CHROMEBOOK (if a student has an existing one).

While laptops are the preferred device, students may use an existing iPad until the need to upgrade this device (iPads with 32 GB or above, WiFi and a full surround case). iPad minis are not acceptable.

*Please note: Android devices e.g. Samsung laptops/tablets are not supported on the school's network.

PURCHASING DETAILS

Devices can be purchased through the CSPD BYOD program <https://byod.parra.catholic.edu.au> or through any technology store (e.g Apple Store, Officeworks, Harvey Norman, JB HiFi).

It is highly recommended to purchase extended warranty, a full coverage sturdy case and some form of personal insurance for your child's device.

Earphones: It is recommended that students have their own personal earphones or headphones to be used as a learning tool each day and for online testing.

Technical Support

- All CSPD (Catholic Schools Diocese of Parramatta) schools and users will have access to *Google suite for Education* incorporating all the applications needed for learners, including access to unlimited drive storage for Google Docs, Slides, Sheets.
- Students can gain access to install Microsoft Office 365 at no extra cost, however any additional software required may need to be sourced by the student/family. (Please contact the St Agnes IT department for more details)
- The school's ICT (Information & Communication Technology) team will assist students with technical difficulties they may experience.
- Once the student commences, their device will be enrolled into our management system which will provide the devices with access to WiFi services. (CEDP EdNet)
